NDHSAA TOURNAMENT CODE OF CONDUCT

PURPOSE: To elevate standards of Good Sportsmanship and to encourage the growth of responsible citizenship among the students, member schools, and their personnel.

Fundamentals of Good Sportsmanship

1. Know, appreciate and understand the rules of the contest.
2. Show respect for the officials. Good Sportsmanship implies the willingness to accept and abide by the decisions of the officials.
3. Show respect for the opponent at all times. Good Sportsmanship is the Golden Rule in action.
4. Recognize and appreciate the skill of performance regardless of team affiliation.
5. Maintain self control at all times. Good Sportsmanship is a responsibility of all who are involved in the game.
6. Show a positive attitude in cheering, refraining from intimidation or negative cheering. Good Sportsmanship is cheering your own team "on to victory."

Acts of Misconduct

1. Throwing of any object onto the playing floor or in the stands.
2. Behavior deemed dangerous or which interferes with the rights of others to watch the game.
3. Possessing, consuming, or being under the influence of chemicals.
4. Use of obscene, profane, or abusive language or gestures, signs, posters, or banners which show disrespect for opponent's team, officials, cheerleaders, band or other performing groups.
5. The use of noisemakers.
6. Entry onto the playing surface at any time.

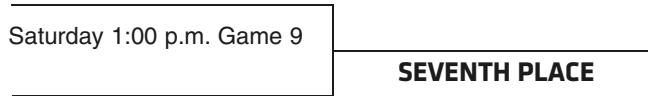
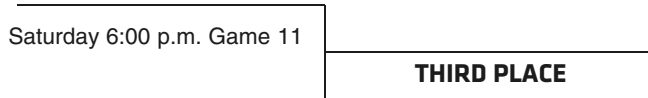

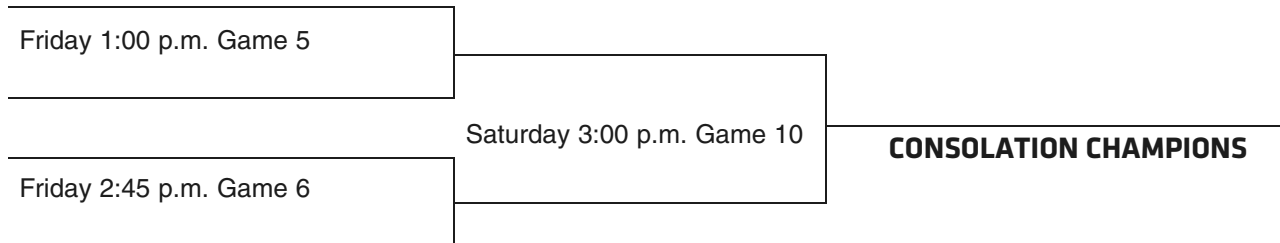

North Dakota Officials Association Hall of Fame Inductees

David Wenger - Williston



David Wenger, formerly of Williston, is the newest member of the North Dakota Officials Association Hall of Fame. David currently works as the Rocky Mountain Area Sales Manager for Weatherford in Denver, Colorado. He and his wife Betty have two grown daughters – Ariel (31), a teacher, and Casalea (27), a registered nurse.

David began his officiating career in 1977 working high school basketball games. He later became a high school football official, where he worked 17 seasons with the Williston Basin Officials Association. David was a member of the North Dakota Officials Association and served one term on their Board of Directors. He was also a member of the National Federation of Officials and was named North Dakota Boys' Basketball Active Official of the Year in 2006-07.

Before his retirement from officiating following the 2011-12 basketball season, David estimates that he officiated over 2000 basketball games during his 35 year career. His officiating highlights include working 15 state basketball tournaments, 36 different regional basketball tournaments, and over 25 football playoff games, including a pair of Division 3A championship games.

David Johnson - Minnewaukan



David Johnson, Minnewaukan, is the newest member of the North Dakota Officials Association Hall of Fame. He is the owner of Johnson Insurance Agency of Minnewaukan and Maddock and Ag Resources of Maddock. David and his wife Karen have three children, Derek, Kylie, and Tanner, along with grandchildren Zach, Jessica, and Charley.

David began his officiating career in 1972 working high school basketball games. During his 37-year high school career, he served many years as the head of the Minnewaukan Officials Association. David was also a member of the North Dakota Officials Association and served two terms on their Board of Directors. He was also a member of the National Federation of Officials and was named North Dakota Boys' Basketball Active Official of the Year in 2006-07. David also served as a NDHSAA basketball area workshop supervisor and was a clinician at various officiating camps for 17 years.

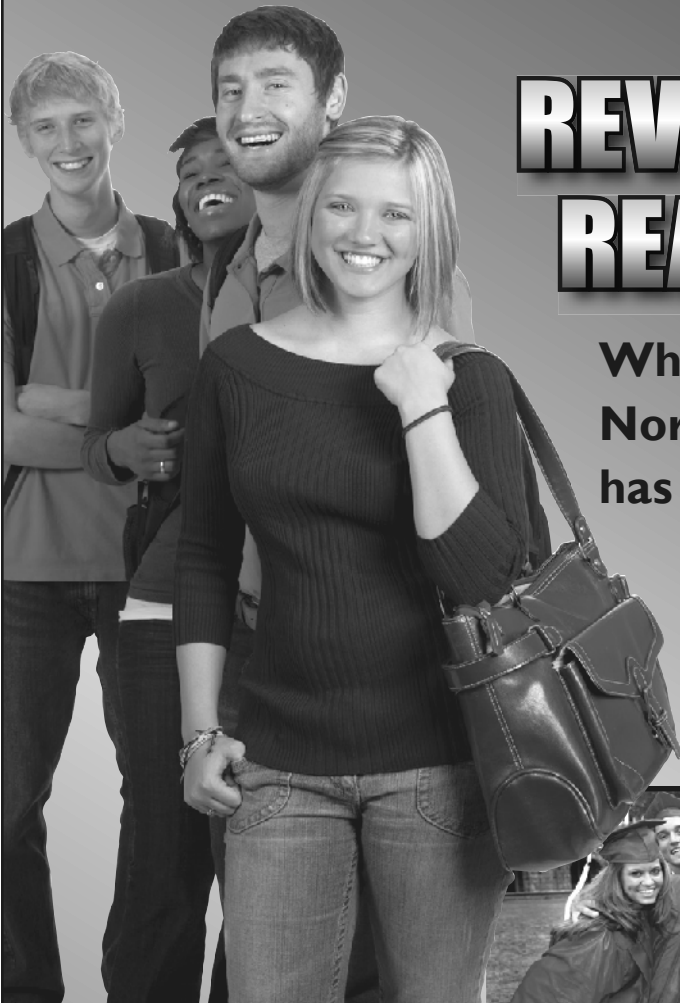
David retired from high school officiating following the 2009-10 basketball season, where he worked the State B Boys' Basketball championship game in a remarkable fifth decade. He continues to officiate college basketball, working in the Northern Sun, Mon-Dak and several Division I conferences. David is also an observer of basketball officials for the Big Sky Conference. During his illustrious career, David estimates that he officiated over 4000 basketball games, highlighted by him working 40 different NDHSAA state basketball tournaments.

1988 STATE B CHAMPIONS – EDINBURG SPARTANS



Edinburg capped a perfect 27-0 season winning the 1988 state championship, defeating Divide County by a score of 64-55. On the way to the title game, the Spartans knocked off Hillsboro and Hankinson at the Bismarck Civic Center. The Spartans had an impressive 82 to 55 scoring average throughout the season. Spartan forward Scott Guldseth was named the 1988 Mr. Basketball. The 1988 title was the only state title for Edinburg and their only appearance in a state basketball tournament.

1963 STATE B CHAMPIONS – KENMARE HONKERS

The Kenmare Honkers won their first state title in 1963 by defeating the New Town Eagles. The Honkers outscored the Eagles by a score of 54-48 at the Minot Municipal Auditorium to collect the championship trophy. The Honkers actually avenged a regional tournament overtime loss to New Town to win the state title. Kenmare defeated Lidgerwood and New Rockford on the way to the title game. The Honkers suffered only three losses on the season. One interesting note is that the starting five for the Honkers played all 96-minutes of the state tournament without relief, rightfully earning the title of “iron men.”



1963 STATE C CHAMPIONS – MAPLETON FALCONS



Mapleton High School won the 1963 Class C state championship by defeating Sharon High School in Jamestown. The Falcons won a tight two point game over North Central in the opening round of the tournament and defeated Butte in the semifinals. The 1963 season was the final year that Class C crowned a champion in North Dakota basketball. The other teams in the 1963 Class C tournament were Flaxton, Fordville, Oriska and Mandaree.
